Connect Day

On Tuesday 30 January, we will be holding our annual Connect Day. This is an opportunity to meet/catch up with your child/ren's learning space teacher/s, find out more about the classroom programme/s, and gather some important upcoming dates and information.

Connect Day Blocks:

6 sessions

Session 1 - 8:30am to 9.30am - Years 1, 3, 5 and 7

Session 2 - 9:30am to 10.30am - Years 2, 4, 6 and 8

Session 3 - 11:00am to 12:00pm - New Entrants/new to school children, Years 3, 5 and 7

Session 4 - 12:00pm to 1:00pm - Years 2, 4, 6 and 8

Session 5 - 1:30pm to 2:30pm - Years 1, 3, 5 and 7

Session 6 - 2:30pm to 3.30pm - Years 2, 4, 6 and 8

Parents/caregivers are asked to select a 1 hour block of time each for their child/ren. This then indicates the hour of time you will spend in each learning space. The blocks will be structured with a 10 minute catch up with all of the children and parents/caregivers at the start. Then for the other 50 minutes, you will stay in the learning space, connecting with other children and their parents/caregivers and maybe completing some information gathering activities with your child/ren. During this 1 hour block, you will also meet with one of the learning space teachers for a 10 minute time slot. Please remember to bring your child/ren too:)

Just another reminder that we have a Teacher Only Day on **Monday 5 February**. We will be meeting as a staff with St Patrick's Kaiapoi to work with Literacy Connections, a professional learning provider. Our focus for the day is to further strengthen our well-established structured literacy practice. This day was chosen that families could enjoy a long weekend.

School Pool

As mentioned in a previous newsletter, there was an opportunity for a parent/caregiver to complete the Introduction to Pool Operations course over the break so that we could open the school pool to the community over Term 1. Unfortunately there was no expression of interest to undertake this training.

I would love to have the pool open to the school community but need to be certain that the school is following all of the rules and requirements expected of us. After a discussion with the School Board, pool keys will be available for hire to members of our school community for use from the start of Term 1 (Wednesday 31 January) until late March (likely depending on the pool temperature). The pool will only be available for those school community members who have purchased a key on WEEKDAYS ONLY and between 3.30pm. to 8.30pm. The school is required to test the water quality each school day as our children are using it, but a qualified person is not available to test over weekends. Pool keys will be available for purchase by school community members for \$30 with an added bond of \$20 refunded at the end of the season with the return of the security fob and key. \$50.00 in total. Please see Kathryn in our school office if you would like to purchase one of these. As in previous years, school accounts to the end of 2023 need to be paid in full prior to uplifting a key.
